## Operation of Snowmobiles

In accordance with City of Humboldt Bylaw No. 16/97 the operation of snowmobiles is prohibited on the following streets and avenues.

1. On Seventh Street from Sixth Avenue to Eighth Ave.
2. On Ninth Street from Fifth Avenue to Eighth Avenue
3. On Sixth Avenue from Seventh Street to Ninth Street
4. On Seventh Avenue from Seventh Street to Ninth St.
5. Provincial Highway No. 5 (Eighth Avenue)
6. Provincial Highway No. 20 (Main Street)

Snowmobile operation is permitted on Provincial Highway 5 and 20 only for the purpose of crossing the highway at right angles. Snowmobiles must be operated at a careful and prudent speed not exceeding 40 km per hour. Maximum fine for contravening bylaw is \$200.00 and impoundment of snowmobile.

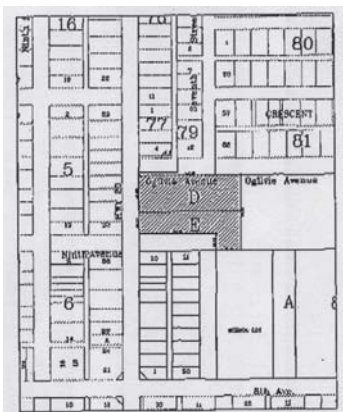
## Public Notice of Zoning Bylaw Amendment

Public Notice is hereby given that the City of Humboldt, pursuant to Section 207 of the Planning and Development Act, 2007, intends to consider adopting a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 02/2008 known as the Zoning Bylaw.

### INTENT:

1. That the Zoning District Map referred to in Section 12.1 of Bylaw No. 02/2008 be amended in the following matter:

- a) By rezoning from CS - Community Services Institutional District to R3-Cz Residential District all of Block D and Block E, Plan 68H05159 as shown crosshatched thus  on the map below:



The reason for this proposed amendment is to allow for an independent retirement living facility on the property.  
**EXAMINATION OF BYLAW:**

This Bylaw may be inspected by interested persons at the City Hall on any judicial day between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. Persons wanting a copy of the bylaw may obtain one free of charge.

### PUBLIC MEETING

Council will be holding a public meeting on Monday, February 22, 2010 at 5:30 pm in the City Hall Council Chambers to receive comments on this bylaw. Interested persons or groups may appear before Council to make representation on the amendment at that time.

### INFORMATION SESSION

An information session will be held on Wednesday, February 17, 2010 from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm at City Hall at 715 Main Street. Questions regarding the proposed development will be answered at this time.
